THE BEGINNING OF LIONS CLUBS INTERNATIONAL

Melvin Johns, Founder
1879 – 1961

Melvin Jones was born on January 13, 1879 in Fort Thomas Arizona, the son of a United States Army captain who commanded a troop of scouts. Later, his father was transferred, and the family moved east. As a young man, Melvin Jones made his home in Chicago, Illinois, became associated with an insurance firm and in 1913 formed his own agency.

He soon joined the Business Circle, a businessmen's luncheon group, and was shortly elected Sec. This group was one of many at that time devoted to solely to promoting the financial interests of their membership. Because of their limited appeal, they were destined to disappear. Melvin Jones, then a 38-year-old Chicago business leader, had other plans.

"What if these men," Melvin Jones asked, "who are successful because of their drive, intelligence, and ambition, were to put their talents to work improving their communities?" Thus, at his invitation, delegates from men's clubs met in Chicago to lay the groundwork for such an organization and on June 7, 1917, Lions Clubs International was born.

Melvin Jones eventually abandoned his insurance agency to devote himself full time to Lions at International Headquarters in Chicago. It was under his dynamic leadership that Lions clubs earned the prestige necessary to attract civic-minded members.

Melvin Jones, the man whose personal code – "You can't get very far until you start doing something for somebody else" – became a guiding principle for public-spirited people the world over, died June 1, 1961 at 82 years of age.

TO ENCOURAGE service-minded men and women to serve their community without personal financial reward, and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works, and private endeavors.

To Show my faith in the worthiness of my vocation by industrious application to the end that I may merit a reputation for quality of service.

To Remember that in building up my business it is not necessary to tear down another's; to be loyal to my clients or customers and true to myself.

Whenever a doubt arises as to the right or ethics of my position or action towards others, to resolve such doubts against myself.

To Hold friendship as an end and not a means. To hold that true friendship exists not on account of the service performed by one another, but that true friendship demands nothing but accepts service in the spirit in which it is given.

Always to bear in mind my obligations as a citizen to my nation, my state, and my community, as to give them my unswerving loyalty in word, act, and deed. To give them freely of my time, labor and means.

To Aid others by giving my sympathy to those in distress, my aid to the weak, and my substance to the needy.

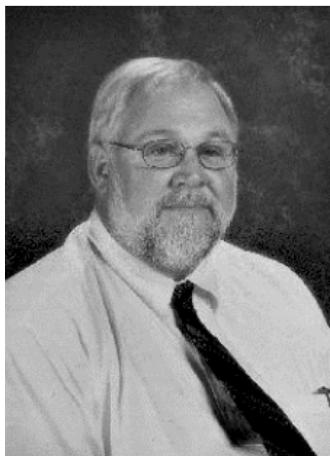

DISTRICT PROTOCOL

Protocol is the term applied to the seating arrangement of officers, dignitaries, and guests. It reflects the way we as Lions run our meetings and being prepared to do our job and not embarrassing anyone, including yourself and the club. In our International Association, we sincerely try to respect rank, which is the basis of discipline, and the basis of a perfectly organized society. We do not subscribe to “protocol” simply because of a desire to outshine, but rather to prove that we are organized and have respect for the fundamental concepts of a discipline which we have imposed upon ourselves voluntarily.

The following are guidelines in that respect:

The American Flag

Display at ALL Meetings, at the Pre’s right as he/she faces the group Pledge of Allegiance to be recited with meaning and dignity.

Club Banner

Display at ALL meetings, at the Pre’s left as he/she faces the group, or directly behind the podium.

Club Meetings

Recommended Head Table Seating Arrangement (facing members)

1. President – Center or left of podium
2. Guest – To President’s right (Right of Podium)
3. Vice President - Left of President
4. Club’s Secretary/Treasurer – Right of Guest

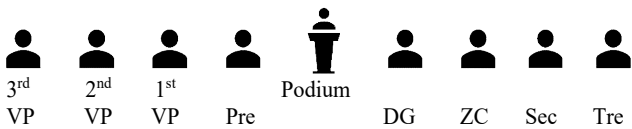
Zone Chairpersons Official Visits

- 1. Zone Chairpersons will make two official visits in addition to their visit with the District Governor
- 2. They do NOT have to be your only program
- 3. They will let you know of important dates, find out how your club is doing and answer any questions the members might have
- 4. It is normal for the club to pay for the meals on these visits

District Governor’s Official Visit

- 1. Three Cabinet Members should be planned for
 - a. District Governor
 - b. Zone Chairperson
- 2. CABINET COMPANIONS WILL NOT ATTEND UNLESS INVITED
- 3. The program will be the District Governor’s message. No other program should be planned.
- 4. If you’d like the Governor to install new members, please inform him/her before the meeting.
- 5. Formal introductions
 - a. Club President introduces the Zone Chairperson
 - b. Zone Chairperson introduces the District Governor
- 6. The District Governor might want to meet with members of the Board of Directors immediately after the close of the official meeting.
- 7. Recommended Head Table Seating Arrangement (facing members)
 - a. Club President – Center or left of podium
 - b. District Governor - To President’s right (Right of Podium)
 - c. Zone Chairperson – Right of District Governor
 - d. Other Club Officers – To President’s Left or Zone Chairperson Right as space allows

District Governor's Goals

District Governor Goals are focused on strengthening our District and making our restructure plan a success. Everything we do is based on our inverted pyramid perspective where Lion members and Clubs are at the top and District Officers are at the base providing help and resources as requested.

1. Realize an increase in membership through recruitment and retention; Clubs are encouraged to hold membership growth events throughout the District.
2. Charter two new Clubs to enhance and grow service to our communities.
3. Provide leadership training for Club and District leaders.
4. Add four new Guiding Lions to our roster to mentor new or existing Clubs.
5. Engage Clubs in two service projects, focusing on one of our global causes.
6. Encourage all members to support Campaign 100 through donating to LCIF, according to their ability.
7. Maintain the team concept of leadership to make available resources requested by our Clubs.

District Governor's Challenges to Clubs

- Clubs should always “Ask 1” to support membership recruitment.
- Clubs should engage all members in activities to enable them to realize their importance and community impact.
- Clubs are encouraged to utilize District Committees for at least two meeting programs throughout the year.
- All Clubs should record membership and service activities on LCI monthly, even if no activity was held during a specific month.
- Clubs are strongly encouraged to increase community awareness of who we are and what we do, and complete Club Quality Initiative Program every 5 years. To keep updated what their community's needs are.
- Clubs are strongly encouraged to attend and support their Region Rally in October.
- Demonstrate to our communities what Lionism is all about by what we do rather than just by what we say: “Demonstrate by Deeds”

District Governor's Contest

The District Governor's Contest gives Clubs to creatively recruit new members who want to serve their community. Clubs that embrace the “Ask One, Be One” are transforming memberships to make sure the future of Lions continue and that needs to be celebrated!

TO BE ELIGIBLE - The club that has the most new members added by the date of the deadline for reservations (March 15, 2021 for Presidents' Honor Night (as per LCI for new members status), will be eligible for the prize, provided the club is in good standing State, and LCI.

PRIZE -- Their club will get their club members free to go to the Presidents' Honor Night. And the winning club, will be announced in the April Newsletter.

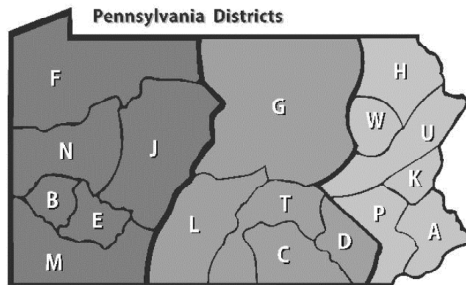

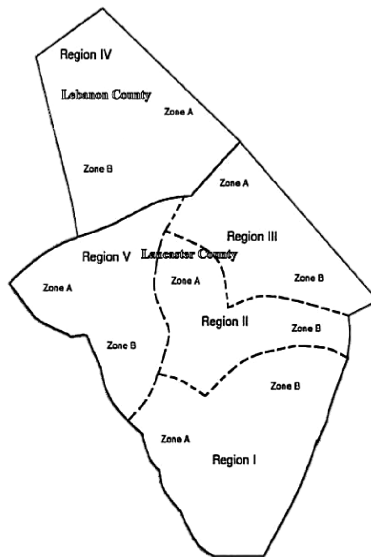
