

It is nestled in the natural woodlands along the Juniata River of Central Pennsylvania just two miles west of Newton Hamilton, near Mount Union. Beacon Lodge was established in 1948 as a summer camp for blind residents of Pennsylvania. It has grown into a favorite retreat for many people with disabilities as well as a conference center for special groups, an educational facility for families, a rental camp for group retreats, and more. The goals of the camp were and are to present a well rounded program adaptable to all campers and others, regardless of age, race, creed or color. Beacon Lodge's Mission Statement is to provide all individuals with special needs, the opportunity to enjoy a camping experience encompassing recreational, educational, and personal adjustment. Special emphasis is placed on stimulating interests and appreciation for recreation and learning, and to encourage attempting new challenges.

**DIABETES AWARENESS** (American Diabetes Assoc : www.diabetes.org) – The American Diabetes Association is the nation's leading nonprofit health organization providing diabetes research, information and advocacy. The mission of the Association is to prevent and cure diabetes and to improve the lives of all people affected by diabetes. 

**MOM'S HOUSE OF LANCASTER** is the only nondenominational faith based nonprofit in Central Pennsylvania that provides support to single parents with young children through free state accredited childcare and education. Infant, Toddler, and Pre-school children receive quality care and early education while their single parents are plugged into a network of supportive services that enable them to complete their education, find jobs and get off of welfare; ultimately to become effective parents, professionals, and community members. Since 1991, MOM'S HOUSE has served over 300 families become empowered to break the cycle of poverty.

## PROTOCOL

Protocol is the term applied to the seating arrangement of officers, dignitaries and guests. It reflects the way we as Lions run our meetings and being prepared to do our job and not embarrassing anyone, including yourself and the club. In our International Association, we sincerely try to respect rank, which is the basis of discipline, and the basis of a perfectly organized society. We do not subscribe to "protocol" simply because of a desire to outshine, but rather to prove that we are organized and have respect for the fundamental concepts of a discipline which we have imposed upon ourselves voluntarily.

The following are guidelines in that respect:

## The American Flag

- Display at ALL Meetings, at the President's right as he/she faces the group
- Pledge of Allegiance to be recited with meaning and dignity

## <u>Club Banner</u>

• Display at ALL meetings, at the President's left as he/she faces the group, or directly behind the podium

Recommended Head Table Seating Arrangement (facing members)

- 1. President Center or left of podium
- 2. Guest To President's right (Right of Podium)
- 3. Vice Presidents Left of President
- 4. Club's Secretary/Treasurer Right of Guest

  - c) Region Chairperson introduces the District Governor
- 6. The District Governor might want to meet with the members of the Board of Directors immediately after the close of the official meeting
- 7. Recommended Head Table Seating Arrangement (Facing Members)
  - a) Club President Center or left of podium
  - b) District Governor To President's or right of the podium
  - c) Region Chairperson Right of District Governor
  - d) Zone Chairperson Right of Region Chairperson or Right of District Governor if no Region Chairperson

The Secretary is the Club's President's "right hand person" and also as importantly the Liaison Officer between the Club and both District 14-D and Lions International. Therefore, a Secretary who performs their duties should be recognized and rewarded.

## **Rules:**

- 1. Contest starts with new Lionistic year on July 1, 2021 and ends on June 30, 2022.
- 2. All Lions Secretaries are automatically entered
- 3. Application can be downloaded from District's Web Page (<u>www.lionsdistrict14d.org</u> Resources/Awards)
- 4. The Zone Chairperson is responsible for giving a signed application to the District Governor by July 31, 2022.
- 5. All Secretaries earning this award will be recognized and receive an award at his/her Region Rally.
