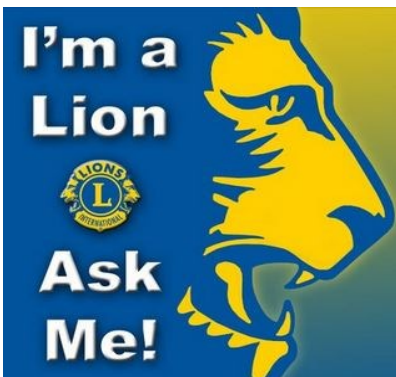

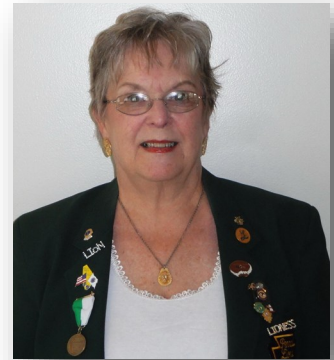
Thoughts from the 2nd Vice District Governor

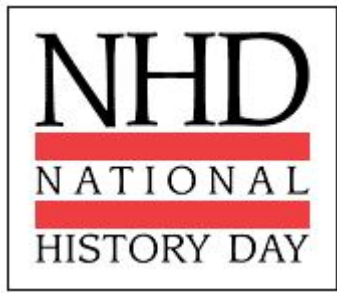

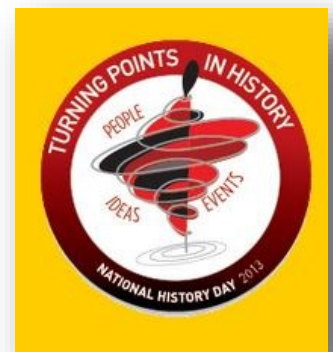
