Message from the 1st Vice District Governor, Dick Sware

I had the opportunity to attend the District 1-A Convention. Due to COVID, the convention was held via Zoom. As you might expect, Multiple District 1 is Illinois with District 1-A being Chicago, the birth-place of Lions. The convention organizers did an outstanding job. It was held on both Saturday & Sunday for approximately 3 hours each day. There were over 125 attendees on Saturday and just under 100 attendees on Sunday. On Saturday, there was a virtual presentation of club banners and a presentation by the Greater Chicago Food Depository. They had the nomination and seconding of their candidates



for 2nd Vice Governor, 1st Vice Governor, and District Governor. The voting for their officers occurred virtually on Sunday during a 2 hour time period prior to the beginning of the Sunday convention session. 



Greetings from PA Lions Beacon Lodge Camp! With all the craziness in the world today, I am happy to announce some great news: With guidance from the American Camping Association (ACA) and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Beacon Lodge will be offering camping sessions during the 2021 season!

As is the case with most businesses, adjustments are necessary. Due to the timeline of the vaccine roll-out, we will be offering a new experience for most of our campers: Virtual Camp!
