I'm sure you heard the saying, "In the Right Place at the Right Time" and you probably experienced it at one time. Well, the East Cocalico Lions recently was "In the Right Place at the Right Time". The club were contacted the by Tammy Frey a nurse in the Cocalico School District. The School District was trying to determine a way to perform vision screening on their students this school year considering the pandemic and mitigation protocols. The scanner and methods they used previously could not be used because of Covid-19 safety issues. The School District found a vision screening device that could be purchased that would permit sight screening, but it was quite expensive, at approx. \$8000. This device can also be used to screen their special needs students in the future, since they are often not able to perform this function due to their limited cognitive or physical limitations. Knowing that vision is one of the club's values, Tammy reached out to the club wondering if they could assist them in any way to help purchase this scanner. Unfortunately, due to the canceling of many of our fundraisers, the club knew it would be difficult to make any meaningful donation toward this piece of equipment. Then the club came up with the Solution! The Northeast Pennsylvania Lions Service Foundation, which one of their members is on the Board of Directors, was created for a situation like this. The Northeast Pennsylvania Lions Service Foundation (NEPALSF), formerly known as Northeast Pennsylvania Lions Eye Bank, was created with the primary goal of eliminating corneal blindness. One of the services they provide is providing Club Sponsored "Grants" to individuals and organizations for Patient Care, Equipment, Professional Education and Community Projects. Most of these Grants are provided without a cost to the club. The East Cocalico Lions completed the paperwork needed for a Grant and sent it to the Grant Committee of the Foundation. They were approved for the Grant in no time and recently presented a check in the amount of \$7, 980 to Tammy and the Cocalico School District. Pictured is Lion Bruce Carpenter presenting the check to Tammy Frey and the Cocalico School District for the purchase of a new vision scanner. Being able to get the Funds needed, even during these times when Finances are low, is just another way that the East Cocalico Lions were in the "Right Place at the Right Time" and were still able to "Serve".
