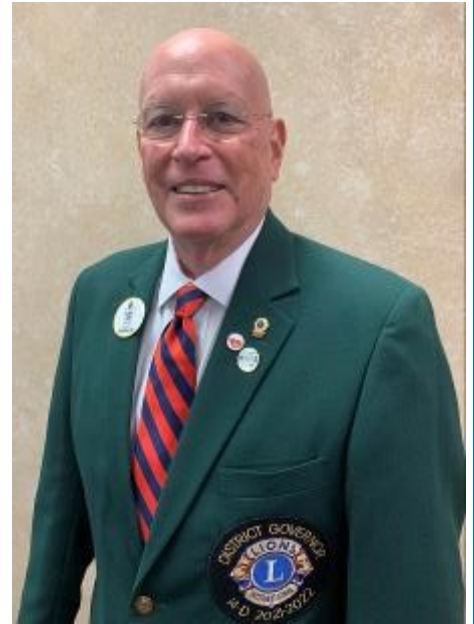


District 14 D- Details

A Message from District Governor Dick Sware

Lions of District 14; Welcome to the beginning of a new Lions Year. I am excited to begin this new year with you.

The 103rd International Convention was held virtually at the end of June. It was a wonderful convention given the restrictions of being virtual. They held a virtual parade of nations. The flags of all member nations were presented to open the First Plenary Session. We saw LCIF presentations by Immediate Past President Gudrun Yngvadottir. Campaign 100 is in full swing with only 1 year left to hit the goal of raising \$300 Million. First Vice President Douglas X. Alexander of Brooklyn, NY was elected and installed as President. His theme for the upcoming year is "Serve From The Heart". You'll be hearing more about President Alexander's theme as the year moves forward. After his installation, President Alexander administered the Oath of Office to the incoming District Governors. I was fortunate to be able to gather with many of my fellow Pennsylvania incoming District Governors in Harrisburg at the State Office for the Oath and the ceremony of pulling the "Elect" ribbon from our name badges. My Partner in Service, Lion Jeanie pulled my ribbon. You'll see pictures from that ceremony in this newsletter.



The District has some ambitious goals this year. I know that by working together we will be able to accomplish these goals. The goals are:

Membership - Establish 2 new clubs. To help with establishing new clubs, the LCI Board of Directors has approved waiving the fee for a new club through December 31, 2021

Membership - Have a positive membership growth of 8 through adding new members and retaining our current members. This will be measured by the number of members we have at the end of the year on June 30, 2022 as compared to the number of members we have at the beginning of the year on July 1, 2021.

Lions Clubs International Foundation - We will support LCIF in Campaign 100 helping to reach their goal of raising \$300 Million

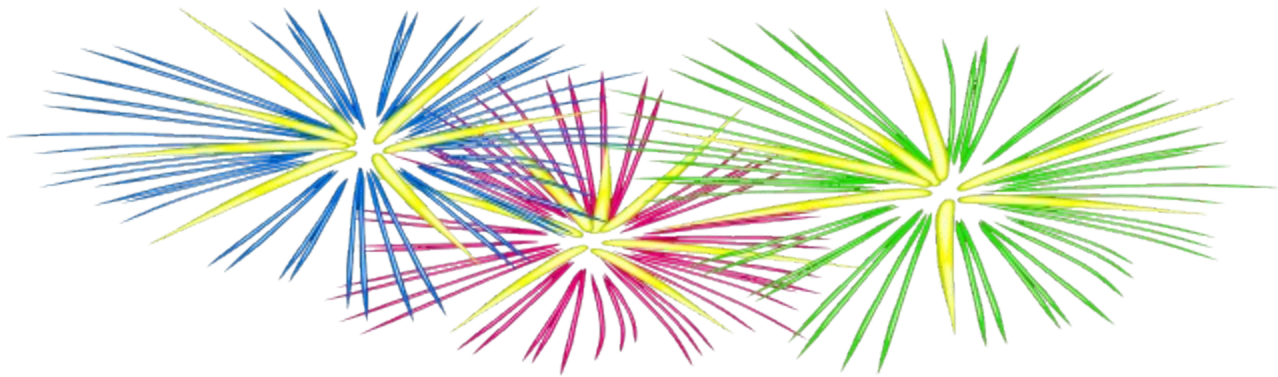
Service - The District will increase the percentage of clubs reporting service in My Lion to 60%. I would truly love to see the great clubs in our District reporting at 75% and believe that is achievable.

Training - The District will conduct training for Zone Chairs and Club Officers prior to the start of the new Lions' year, July 1, 2021. This goal has been achieved with the training coordinated by GLT Coordinator FVDG Carl Spellman in June. Please contact GLT Coordinator Carl if you believe there is a need for Additional training.

I am looking forward to working with all of the clubs in the District throughout the year. I'm especially looking forward to visiting your club. Thankfully the restrictions we faced over the past 1 ½ years are now lifted and we are able to meet in person. More important, we are able to get back out in our communities to Serve from the Heart and provide the service that the communities need.

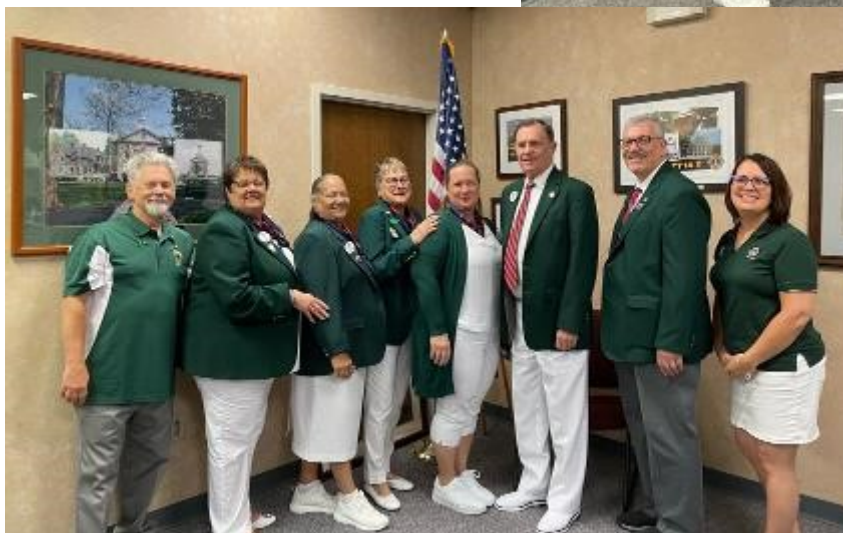

Greetings from PA Lions Beacon Lodge Camp! With all the craziness in the world today, I am happy to announce some great news: With guidance from the American Camping Association (ACA) and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Beacon Lodge will be offering camping sessions during the 2021 season!

As is the case with most businesses, adjustments are necessary. Due to the timeline of the vaccine roll-out, we will be offering a new experience for most of our campers: **Virtual Camp!** Please see the included announcement for an idea of how Virtual Camp works. We are excited to have the opportunity to offer this new program to the Special Needs population from July 10 through July 14.

The sessions that will be virtual:

- Adult Transitional Care – Both sessions
- Adult Assisted Living – All sessions
- Adult Hearing Impaired
- Children's Village – Camp ALIVE
- Children's Village – Assisted Living
- Children's Village – Blind V/I
- Children's Village – ENERGY

In-person sessions will begin on July 17 and include two Visually Impaired sessions in the Adult Camp, and two sessions each of Project New Hope and Family Camp in the Children's Village. Proof of vaccination or of a negative COVID-19 test and result within three days prior to arrival will be prerequisites (16 and older), and COVID-19 mitigation measures will be in effect for all in-person sessions.

If your Club is interested in sponsoring a camper for the 2021 season, please use the included sponsorship form.

Sponsorships will be needed for the Adult Visually Impaired sessions (\$600), and Family Camp (\$450). As in the past, these sponsorships can be made on behalf of specific campers, or they can be undesignated, and assigned by the staff to campers who need them. Noting "Sponsorship, (Camper's Name)", or "Sponsorship, undesignated" in the memo line will assist us with making sure the donation is applied as intended.
