The members of the Northeast PA Lions Service Foundation held their semi-annual retreat on January 8th at the Lions Clubs Pa State Council in Harrisburg. The meeting is important because operations from the previous year are reviewed and plans are developed for the coming year.

The NEPALSF annually supports **Salus University** with student scholarships for students of our coverage area. This year's **grant is \$45,000.00** for a pilot program which offers stipends to students eligible for clinical courses (i.e., internship) so they can devote a full semester to the provision of services (under Salus supervision) at agencies/field placements in the central and northeast sections of PA. A little more information on this program will be in the NEPALSF submission in the next "Pride" publication.

What is "Mailchimp" and Why Am I getting Emails from it

District 14-D realizes that communication with all Lions Club members is important and essential. One of the best, easiest and quickest way to deliver information to Lions Club members is the use of Email. To do this, District 14-D uses a software tool named Mailchimp to manage Email Distribution Lists and send Emails to all members that have an email address registered with Lions Club International. The District also, sends a "Link" each month to the District's newsletter. As part of the email that Mailchimp sends, there is a way to "Unsubscribe" from getting these emails, but it is strongly recommended that you do NOT Unsubscribe since these emails have vital information.

Club Secretaries, please ensure all member emails are correct and updated when changed. If a member claims he is not getting emails or the link for the newsletter send the member's Email Address to PDG Bruce Carpenter (pal4dwiz@ptd.net) so he can add it to Mailchimp's distribution list.
