


Leo of the Year

MD-14 seeks to host 2024 Forum

The 2019-2020 Council of Governors will be asked during its third meeting in State College to endorse a bid proposal to host the 2024 USA/Canada Lions Leadership Forum in Pocono Manor.

The proposal to hold the Forum at the site of the 2019 MD-14 State Convention last May has received the endorsement of the PA International Family and the MD-14 USA/Canada Lions Leadership Forum Committee.

The bid proposal will initially be presented for Council's review and approval at the COG's Preliminary meeting Friday, Feb. 7, before formal approval will be sought at Council's Regular Meeting the following day.

Upon approval by the COG, the bid will be forwarded to the Forum's Site Selection Committee for its review and possible on-site visit in the spring. The final decision on the site of the 2024 Forum will be announced in mid-September at the 44th annual Forum in Louisville, Ky.



The bid proposal will be presented by Ann Pilcher, Sales Manager for the Pocono Mountains Convention & Visitors Bureau. She, along with Stephani Bann, Senior Sales Manager for Kalahari Resort & Convention Center Pocono Mountains - Pennsylvania, has worked in conjunction with MD-14 State Administrator Bob McComas.

Pennsylvania hosted the eighth Forum (1984) in Philadelphia but was unsuccessful in its attempt to secure the host bid for the 2022 Forum in York. The Forum has not been held in a Mid-Atlantic or northeast state since 1997, when Syracuse hosted the event.






PA state pins

The 2019-2020 Council of Governors, during its third meeting in State College, will be asked to approve designs for the 2020-2021 MD-14 state pins as presented by the Pin Traders of Pennsylvania.

The Pin Traders request approval of the design shown at the top of the right-hand column on this page as the "Regular" state pin and the design immediately below that as the "Prestige" pin.

 A good supply of 2019-2020 state pins remain available for purchase through the State Office Merchandise Store. The Regular pin (top left photo) is priced at \$3.18 perpin, while the cost of the Prestige pin (bottom left photo) is \$4.24 per pin, including state tax. Order forms for the 2019-2020 pins will appear in the next two issues of The Pride of Pennsylvania.






Parade participant pins

International Board of Directors approves dues adjustment resolution

The following message was emailed 11/20/19 by International President Dr. Jung-Yul Choi to Council Chairpersons, District Governors, Vice District Governors and Past District Governors and is being shared here to help assure the message reaches all MD-14 Lions:

Lions Clubs International supports clubs and members around the world so we can advance our global mission of service together. Our international support and the work of Lions Clubs International is fueled by the international dues of our incredible members.

At the International Board of Directors meeting in October, the Board voted to approve an international dues adjustment resolution that will be voted on at the International Convention in Singapore in 2020.

In recent years, it has become increasingly clear that the services Lions Clubs International has been able to provide to members with the available budget is no longer in line with what Lions need and expect.

The Board of Directors undertook an extensive review of Lions Clubs International's financials, including the implementation of substantial budget reductions. After much consideration, the board proposed to adjust dues by US\$3 effective July 2021, raising dues to US\$46, then adjusted annually for U.S. inflation thereafter. We will use a three-year inflation average not to exceed 3.0% or be lower than 1.5%.

Why an international dues adjustment is needed


We realize the association has been reluctant to adjust dues over the years, and we have not adjusted international dues since 2011. The proposed adjustment will help cover our costs and allow us to suitably serve our members' needs. With that said, the Board of Directors did not take this issue lightly, nor are we minimizing the value of each dollar that our members contribute.

As we consider this dues adjustment, it is essential that we keep in mind that our global efforts

and initiatives support more than 1.4 million members in 48,000 clubs around the world. Through the support of staff, we are able to serve globally on the level that we do, keeping members and clubs fully supported with service resources, training events and software, club operational support, international meetings, language services, technology, Foundation support, leadership support, and everything else we have come to expect as Lions.

A dues adjustment will allow Lions Clubs International to provide improved support to Lions and

programs and digital products such as our website and MyLion. It will also allow us to invest in new programs such as a new online learning platform, development of new curriculum such as digital literacy, training videos, global advertising, marketing automation, digital and video storytelling and others tools and initiatives that will enhance our impact, our brand, and our membership.



Why your help is needed

Essentially, we have to decide whether or not we want Lions Clubs International to continue to grow and thrive. Lions is more than a way of life. It's also an investment of money, time, energy and passion. As with any good investment, the more we put in, the more returns we see.

We need you to help our members and leaders understand why this adjustment is needed. We have developed an international dues adjustment FAQ and PPT to help you present it to your Lions.

I hope that you will see this adjustment as we do: as an investment in the future of Lions. Through your support, we can ensure that Lions are positioned for success in the future.
